If the determination has been made that EPA reporting is <u>NOT REQUIRED</u>, please complete the following certification. Reporting/disclaim guidance follows below.

Do I need to Report or Disclaim Vehicle and Engine Information to EPA for my Product(s)?

The Clean Air Act prohibits import into the U.S. of any motor vehicle, motor vehicle engine, non-road engine (gas, diesel, marine, stationary), or equipment that does not conform to EPA emission standards and requirements. If your product is one of these types of products, and not included in the above disclaimer descriptions, EPA Vehicle and Engine (V&E) information must be reported to EPA and a disclaimer would not be appropriate, even if certain information is not required (i.e. light duty vehicle at least 21 years old). If you determine filing is required, complete EPA Form 3520-1 (light duty/on road) or EPA Form 3520-21 (heavy duty highway/off-road) instead.
